

NOTICE

Seasonal Load and Speed Limits

In accordance with the provisions of Section 702 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as amended, the Montmorency County Road Commission will impose seasonal load and speed limits on all Montmorency County roads except those specifically exempted, **at 8:00 a.m. on March 16, 2022**, and remain in effect until further notice. The allowable gross axle loadings are those listed under seasonal loads in the following table:

NO OVERWEIGHT LOADS (SINGLE TRIP OR YEARLY) WILL BE PERMITTED BY THE MONTMORENCY COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION WHILE SPRING WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ARE IN EFFECT.

ALL SEASON ROUTES:

The following Montmorency County Roads will be exempt from seasonal weight and speed restrictions:

- *Co. Rd. 451 from Hillman to North County Line
- *Co. Rd. 459 from Co. Rd. 451 to Co. Rd. 624
- *Co. Rd. 624 from Co. Rd. 459 to M-33
- *Pleasant Valley Road from Hillman to Hall Road
- *Hall Road from Pleasant Valley Road to M-32/M-33
- *Reimann Road from M-33 south to M-32 west
- *Co. Rd. 612 from M-33 to county 4-corners (Old 612)
- *Co. Rd. 489 from Oscoda County north to Co. Rd. 612
- *Co. Rd. 491 from Co. Rd. 612 to M-32
- *Airport Rd. from Co. Rd. 491 to Kneeland St.
- *Buttles Road from M-32 south to the end of blacktop
- *Veteran's Memorial Highway
- *State Street from M-32 to Veteran's Memorial Highway
- *Carrier Road from Co. Rd. 451 to Industrial Park Drive
- *Co. Rd. 487 from M-32 south to Co. Rd. 612

NOTE-As in the past, the Montmorency County Road Commission will be allowing designated, legal loading and speeds on an hour-to-hour, day-to-day basis. Call 989-785-3334 Ext. 1 on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday after 3:00 P.M. for the following day's designated loading hours. Call after 3:00 P.M. on Friday for Saturday, Sunday, and Monday's designated loading hours.

Cold, cloudy weather will allow more designated loading hours than warm and/or sunny weather. Usually, more hours of designated loading will be allowed early in the Spring Restricted Season and then less toward the end.
