Cheryl McCormick, Avery Lake resident, presented an update on Avery Lake shoreline restoration. Ms. McCormick commended Superintendent Bill Koenig for his assistance with taking care of sumps on Avery Lake Road and Shoreline Drive. She recommended that we not blade so close to the shoulder on a certain section of Avery Lake Road.

The Managing Director's report was as follows: Received an email from EGLE requesting the status of the contamination at the Atlanta garage- all documentation has been put into storage for Bill Henn to review. Due to issues with Frontier moving fiber optic lines, the Hossler Road timber bridge project is on hold until possibly December. MDOT's ProjectWise and AASHTOWare programs are not working properly at this time. A meeting with a FEMA representative for ice storm damage reimbursement is scheduled for September 23, 2025. Would like to implement a sign policy stating that road name signs will only be replaced either once or twice a year as they are being stolen constantly. Will be looking into purchasing another water truck soon. 8-hour days will begin October 5, 2025.

The Superintendent's report was as follows: Maintenance activities consisted of cutting trees, blading roads and cutting brush. Construction activities consisted of continued construction on Edgar Road, McMurphy Road, Co. Rd. 459 and Hayes Road.
