CRA's legislative priorities will be discussed at the August Straits Area meeting. Need a consensus vote from the board regarding requested changes to CRA's By-Laws. Discussion was held on CRA statewide schedule of fees. Samsara Company will be doing a

presentation on GPS tracking on trucks next week. GFL will be cleaning drains in Lewiston and Atlanta on July 25, 2024.
